
- Choosing the project

Process

First Engagement Session - Survey

- ► 136 responses
- Participants were students, staff, and bus drivers
- Major student concerns were:
 - Safety
 - Shelter
 - Bus Information



Preparing for the Workshop

- Difficult to attract a crowd
- ► Turning user comments into design


Second Engagement Session - Workshop

- 9 participants
 - ► Mostly planning and engineering students
- Support for shelters, particularly a library shelter
- Major support for median and removing the loop
- Low support for raised crosswalks
- Students want more transit information
